## PAPER FORMATTING GUIDELINES

1. Submitted papers must be at least 4 pages long.
2. The paper should be prepared in Microsoft Office Word format with the following settings: font – Times New Roman, font size – 14, line spacing – 1, alignment – justified, margins: top and bottom – 20 mm, right – 15 mm, left – 30 mm. All images and tables must be numbered and accompanied by titles or graphic captions.
3. Paper formatting:
  - **TITLE** of the **PAPER** (in uppercase letters, centered) must be written in the language of the paper, with translations in Russian/ Kazakh and English;
  - Author information (1 line below the title, single-spaced): Full name(s) (no more than 5 authors), academic degree, title, position, organization, city, email address, and ORCID;
  - Abstract (no more than 150 words) must be provided in the language of the paper, along with Russian/ Kazakh and English translations. The abstract should be placed before the main text;
  - 5–7 keywords in three languages (Kazakh, Russian, English) following the abstract;
  - Main text (single-spaced, following the keywords);
  - References (single-spaced, after the main text).
4. The reference list is mandatory and must be formatted according to GOST 7.0.100-2018 standards.
5. The paper must adhere to research ethics, ensuring originality and the absence of plagiarism, proper citation and necessary references, data accuracy and reliability, confidentiality of research participants' data (if applicable).
6. All materials should be sent to the Organizing Committee's email in two separate files: Application and paper in text named as «Name and surname (first authors', if there are more than one author) \_ Application» и «Name and surname (first authors', if there are more than one author) \_ Paper».
